- Darcy Walsh speaker about how his club RI Adelaide changed trend of falling numbers. How change was achieved ...
- Data collected on needs of clubs shows a common theme of member recruitment
- Checked new members for their perceptions of RI before joining
- Rotary Club of Adelaide lost 30% in 5 years
- Some recruitment through corporate membership which had some flow on effect
- Problem seen as getting new people "in the door"
- Need to improve gender balance
- Minimalise trivia at meetings
- 5 steps
  - Raise awareness of RI and the club
  - Getting club ready by informing, initiating change and improving culture
  - Find potential members
  - Be welcoming, establish good practice
  - Retain members
  - Awareness and commitment
- Problems identified and addressed
- Investigate and use what other clubs are doing to succeed
- Develop membership focus of all
- Plan vision, purpose, objectives
- Do skills audit, profiles of members to enable use of skills
- Align the club with RI brand eg updated logo to match current official logo
- Self evaluation eg websites up to date and inviting
- Be open and welcoming to new members, visitors, speakers etc.
- Find potential new members eg Asked all members to each name 3 potential members to invite to info session
- Invite attendees to attend meetings, help with projects or events, send them club bulletin for 4 weeks
- Ask what they would like to do and help them to do it
- Involve in committees
- Use mentors
- Held regular new members' "fireside chats"
- Now have monthly social evenings as there is little, if any, time in lunch time meetings.
- Takes time and commitment
- Use RI membership resources and support from district
- Be clear on need for change, inform & get commitment and involvement from all stakeholders
- Set clear objectives
