Protect yourself from Scams

Based at Nuri and local service area, 7 years in Gawler.

Beware the questions, do not call back missed calls, different types of scams, Internet lets people in ,Identity theft.

Considerable increase in recent years – suspect many not reported.

Include phone, computer, text messages, viruses, classified advertisements, itune cards,

Threat of arrest, romance, befriending on line and asking for finance, fake internet provider, prizes, sextortion, threat of revealing images, demand money.

Target people seeking jobs -could involve handling stolen goods, money laundering.

Business email –manipulate texts, gain access to email, intercept emails, ransomware software, encrypt data

Phishing – aim to steal personal details to gain access to funds, information etc

Security software, backup regularly, caller id may not be safe, change passwords regularly, do not disclose passwords/ pin, 2FA (Two Factor Authentication)
