- 100 year Celebration; oldest club in Asia
- Focus on projects in field of social business eg micro finance
- 6.5 million women in poverty helped to establish business
- Professor Eunice speaker on zero world concept
- Dump called Smoky Mountain in most poverty stricken area of Manilla. Families in poverty live in this area and rely on scavenging to survive.
- Sari Sari Store Training Project to provide better alternative.
- Sari Sari are small general convenience shops which are common in Manila.
- Training for 15 22 year olds "How to run convenience store"
- 15 20 graduates in first instance. Plans to train more
- Projects in Cambodia aim to address rural poverty
- Chicken farm set up with assistance of Marilyn and Ian Curtis
- Now extending the farm project to establish farms in other Cambodian communities.
- Max 500 chickens per farm
- Short video shown of the Chicken Farm
- Aim to employ people previously scavenging at local dump
- Better nourishment of children and reliable source of quality protein
- Traditional food supply now diminished
- Setting up of breeder farm now proceeding
- Buildings and machines cost \$800 and constructed so that it can be moved to new location if required
- Loan for chickens and feed for start-up
- Help needed to raise funds and also to work on site as volunteer
- \$1300 per farm needed to set up and start each farm including solar panels etc
- Targeting youth
