- Gwenda grew up in Hamley Bridge
- Married 53 years
- Moved to Gawler in 2000
- Husband diagnosed with cancer
- 2020 Australia Day award
- Gail lost husband to brain cancer in 2000
- Volunteered for relay for life. Continued involvement
- Relay for Life in Gawler started 2009. Last year raised \$50000. Has raised over half a million.
- Together raised one and a half million.
- 2 April 2022 next Relay for Life
- Joined small group which has now been together 25 years
- Function at Jockey Club raises funds
- Involvement with troubled youth group
- Restricted by covid
- This year going ok particularly collecting cans at car wash
- Greenhill lodge for country people needing treatment. New lodge being built. Raising funds currently aiming to furnish a room for a couple. Will have rooms for couples and singles and also have play area for children, gym and special furniture.
- Over 10000 South Australians diagnosed with cancer each year. Families impacted. Funding shortfall \$6million this year
- Apex Cabin in Wallaroo caravan park \$50 for a week for people with cancer including their family
- Aim to reduce number of people who die with cancer
- Relay conducted over 20 hours overnight
- Many volunteers involved in various aspects of Cancer Council
