- Assisted as editor on uni paper & union
- Bought hearse for travel and led funeral astray
- Trip to Cornwall. Police incident.
- Egypt trip campsite was actually military base. Allowed to camp on lawn there.
- Playing bridge on boat
- Emigrated to Australia intending to stay 5 years but stayed
- 2 children
- Bought partnership in dentistry
- Bought vintage aircraft
- Joined Rotary Club of Tea Tree Gully
- Became Club President, and then District Governor
- Volunteered dental expertise around world with Les as dental nurse
- Started Rotary Club of Gawler Light in 1996 with Barry Treloar and became first President
- Variety of experiences in dental field
- Retired at 65, became bored, now tutoring at dentistry at University one day a week
