- Mr and Mrs Sokham Weekly KPI Summary Report
- Total Birds Place = 360
- Total Sold Chicken = 225
- Total Mortality = 31
- Remaining birds in shed = 104 (will be sold on Monday)
- Mortality Percentage = 8.61%
- Survival Percentage = 91.39%
- Net profit will be 55c per bird sold
- With sales on Monday they will make a profit of \$180 on this batch which equates (including down time between batches) to USD \$2.00 a day net income for the family
