<u>Guest Speaker:</u> Jim Mavromatis - Guitars for Veterans

- I am 77 but I look young
- I walk 10,000 steps a day
- I joined the Army when I was 17, did 3 months, hated it, did my core training, was selected for intelligence but went into infantry
- Went to one battalion, where there were guys from the 2nd world war; I knew nothing about war but had 11 great teachers who had been in many different conflicts
- We trained for warfare; they taught me so much, like how you can eat the back legs of a frog
- Then Vietnam war started up; I was disappointed I didn't get to go with the guys then I was given 33 guys in my platoon who didn't want to be there
- Every day I ran these hippies to the rifle range then ran them back again; the main thing I learned was that you had to be fit and how to use your rifle?
- I progressed and our battalion went to Vietnam; I didn't know when there I had illness

- I went to the medical centre; they thought
 I had a bleeding ulcer; I could not eat anything; I was then sent to an American Hospital
- A Jeep took me back to Australian Hospital meanwhile my blood count was getting lower and lower
- My phlegm was tested and they found I had hook worms
- They sucked fluid out of my lungs and my stomach; the eggs were getting into my lungs then going into the blood to the ulcer and feeding from the ulcer; they gave me 6 tables and waited after the first test within days, the nurses were giving me iron tablets
- I was then posted to Balcombe which was a school of music and there I was invited to Vets USA
- We don't get support from the government like the USA does and we have a person in each State who looks after people in that State

We are very grateful to Laurens for helping at the Breakfast Club

- We give them 5 free guitar lessons to Veterans who may be suffering from trauma
- We seek out Veterans who suffer from trauma
- All we do is tell our stories; I wait until I have 5 vets
- In one case the wife was being beaten; the veteran kept his guitar in front of the fridge and by doing that when he goes to the fridge for a beer, he sees his guitar and picks it up and starts playing and forgets all about the beer
- 400 veterans have gone through the program; since January last year we have dealt with over 100 vets
- I discovered that the only way you can change is from the inside
- I have written many songs, so now I have produced Big Jim's Album
- Booze doesn't work, pills work if you're working with a psychiatrist. My wife knew how to keep me focused, any change comes from within
- Jim played his guitar and sang two songs
